Professor Tenzin Norbu is an experienced teacher of Tibetan language and culture at both the secondary school and university levels, having taught at Virginia University, Indiana University, and Columbia University, as well as in his native city of Lhasa. He authored or co-authored the Tibetan-language children's books *A Little Frog and a Crow* and *Little Shepherd, Little Shepherd, What Are You Doing?*, as well as a dictionary for children, the *Concise Tibetan-English Visual Dictionary*. A biologist by training, Professor Norbu published a general introduction to Tibet's environment and two volumes on endangered species of Tibet. Finally, he is also an accomplished translator, and translated eight volumes of the *Open Eye Children's Series* into Tibetan.

Professor Norbu will tailor the content of the course to the level of the attendees.
